Each week Lou brings together a panel of guests to discuss/debate and shed some light on topics torn from the headlines yet ignored by the mainstream media. **Rape, Murder, Gang Violence, Internet Predators/Pedophiles** no topic is off limits for Lou to confront.

Nothing is more troubling than the rampant crime that pollutes our streets. “**Street Wise**” will expose the out of control costs associated with this lawlessness. Unlike the “Talking Heads” that host other shows, Lou is a highly decorated NYC Police Officer with a law enforcement career spanning 5 decades. Throughout the debate Lou is armed with **Facts & Stats** and prepared to shoot holes in any arguments that is not supported by the **evidence**. He will make sure guests stay on point so the **truth** is revealed without the slant of spin or hyperbole.

“**Street Wise**” will be segmented with a variety of production pieces intended to keep the show interesting and moving. These segments will be inserted based on time constraints/need and topic. These unique segments include:

“**Back On The Beat**” - Lou plays Lead Detective as he and a panel of guest Law Enforcement Officers take a fresh look at cases that may have run cold or never been solved.

“**10-13 Officer Down**” - As a tribute to our fallen heroes Lou will spotlight the story of a fellow officer lost/wounded in the line of duty. This segment is intended to pay homage to those who have made the ultimate sacrifice while preserving the peace. It also raises awareness for organizations set up to help the families of these brave public servants lost in the line of duty.

“**Street Tactics**” Lou along with a trained guest, will give pointers/demonstrations on how law-abiding citizen’s can defend themselves against the typical street attacker.
